



Preschool/ Kindergarten Registration Overview

This is an overview of Summit Academy registration requirements as an American Curriculum aligned with the MOE (Ministry of Education and Higher Education) regulation.

Age Requirement

In order to be eligible for kindergarten admission, a student must have attained the age of three (3) years for Preschool, four (4) years for KG1 and five (5) years for KG2 on or before September 30 of the academic year.

New Students Requirements

1. Completed Application (no missing data or submissions)
2. 3 updated photos (passport size)
3. Updated Health Profile with Immunization Card (current)
4. Health File (*from Health Center-call 107*)
5. School Records (if transferee)
6. Certificate of Good Moral Character (if transferee)
7. Filled in Request for Bus - if applying for transportation
8. Payment of Registration (one-time payment)
9. Payment of Seat Reservation (as required yearly and deducted from tuition)
10. Parent Employment Certificate

Student's Placement

Student who is born on October 1 to December 31 with below acceptable academic performance is subject to grade placement review.

Appropriate program and grade level placement decisions ensure a successful kindergarten experience and avoid disruption of a student's schedule of progress & milestones during the school year.

Transferring Students from Different Curriculum

Age ranges from compulsory educational requirements of home country using government school classification.

Grade placement of a student transferring from different curriculum is reviewed based on the State of Qatar's School Classification Guideline.
